RACE RULES

1. The race takes place under the rules of the IAAF, ASA and CGA. 2. Athletes indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organisers of the races against any or all actions of whatsoever nature, whatever the same may arise out of their participation in the race. 3. All athletes participate at their own risk. Athletes acknowledge by entering the event that they are medically fit to participate. All athletes must supply the name and contact number of their next of kin on both the race number and entry form. 4. Licensed athletes must wear club colours and their 2018 licence number back and front, with the race number worn on the front of vest. Licensed athletes who do not wear their 2018 licence number must purchase a temporary licence on the day or face disqualification. 5. Temporary licensed athletes to wear plain clothing with the issued temporary licence on the back of their vest. 6. Athletes competing for category prizes must wear clearly visible age tags of the appropriate size, on the back and front of their running vest. 7. Athletes may not run with another athlete's race number unless by prior arrangement with the race organiser. 8. No seconding allowed. 9. No headphones. Any ear plugged devices, excluding hearing aid devices, are in contravention of IAAF rule 144.2b and may lead to disqualification. 10. Walkers competing for prize money must wear short pants, any long pants covering the legs will lead to disqualification. 11. Blatant running by any walkers will lead to immediate disqualification. 12. Walkers must wear "Walker" tags on the back and front of their running vest. 13. International athletes must provide a clearance letter from their country of origin in the event of them winning a prize.

14. No blades, cyclists or mechanically operated devices allowed in the race. 15. Pets and prams are welcome. 16. All instructions from traffic, race and technical officials must be obeyed at all times. 17. Proof of age for prize winners is required and must be presented to the referees before prize giving. Prizes will be withheld until all the necessary details of the winners are confirmed. 18. Only those who have completed all the information in the race entry are eligible for prizes. 19. No refunds. 20. Objections must be lodged within 30 minutes (before or after the prize giving) in writing to the chief referee accompanied by R300 which is refundable if the appeal is upheld. 21. The total prize value is R34 300 in cash. 22. Prize winners will be announced at the event on Sunday, 5 August 2018 at 10H00. 23. Any prize not redeemed for any reason within two weeks of notification will be forfeited. 24. The prizes are strictly cash, is not transferrable and cannot be exchanged for other items. 25. The race organiser retains the right to refuse entry and eject persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, who are disorderly, or engage in inappropriate behaviour, vandalism or evade paying for admission. 26. Athletes who participate without buying a race entry will be disqualified, and will not be entitled to any benefits associated with the race and will be liable for a double entry fee charge. Habitual offenders (those who regularly participate without purchasing a race entry) will be called to a CGA disciplinary. 27. Licensed athletes not wearing club colours may face disqualification. 28. Littering is not allowed. Athletes are to dispose of any litter in appropriate bins. Athletes can be disqualified if they litter. 29. Athletes must be 14 years or older to participate in the 10k. 30. No race number, no result, no negotiation.
