The Race Rules / Entry Conditions:

Administration fee is cost effective; therefore, entry fees will not be refundable under any circumstances.

Do not duplicate your entry form.

TEMPORARY LICENCE

The 42.2km event is open to runners with a valid ASA License; unlicensed entrants are required to purchase a temporary license.

Unlicensed entrants in the 21 km and 10 km event are required to purchase a temporary license with their entry at the cost of R15(10 KM) & R20 (42 KM & 21 KM) to be able to take part in the race.

DATE AND TIME OF RACE

- The **42.2 KM Marathon** will be Run on **Sunday 21 July 2019**, Starting at **6h00 AM** and Finish at **12h00 Middy** which is a 6 Hour Cut-Off.
- The **21 KM Marathon** will be Run on **Sunday 21 July 2019**, Starting at **5h30 AM** and Finish at **08h30 AM** which is a 3 Hour Cut-Off.
- The **10 KM Marathon** will be Run on **Sunday 21 July 2019**, Starting at **5h30 AM** and finish at **07h30 AM** which is a 2 Hour Cut-Off.

Your race pack, which will contain your race number, ChampionChip (if ordered) and temporary licence (if ordered), must be collected prior to the race from the Number Collection Venue on the following dates and times:

Thursday, 18 July 2019 - 10h00 AM to 19h00 PM

Friday, 19 July 2019-10h00 AM to 17h00 PM



RACE KIT

Participants must wear club colours that have been officially registered and approved by their provincial body and in accordance with IAAF/ASA and KZNA rules. Participants running with a temporary license need to wear plain, unbranded clothing.

Parking
